This full day class will give instruction in making a basic landscape quilt with emphasis on perspective, layering and balance of color and value. Students will learn about turned edges, invisible machine appliqué and fusing as we capture the beauty of our WV mountains.

## **SUPPLY LIST (FOR ALL STUDENTS)**

Sewing machine in good working order  
with zig zag capabilities

Power strip or extension cord

Open toe foot; free motion foot

Invisible (monofilament) thread in both clear and smoke

Bobbin weight thread #50 or #60

Schmetz Microtex sewing machine needles size #70

Basic sewing kit: pins, seam ripper, small sharp scissors, marking pencil, stiletto,  
pencil and paper, etc.

Fine black Sharpie marker

## **SUPPLY LIST BELOW THE LINE IS FOR STUDENTS NOT PURCHASING A KIT**

(\*see below)

1 yard Pellon 910 midweight stabilizer

1 yard Wonder Under

(no substitutions, please)

1 yard freezer paper

Sky: 8" x 20" bright golden yellow

River: 1 fat quarter of light blue

Mountains: 12-14 fabric pieces

approximately 8" x 18" or fat

quarters in a wide range of colors and values in greens, blues, violets  
and earth tones

Foreground trees: 8" x 20" piece of dark fabric

Sun: scrap of yellow orange

Rhododendron and leaves: fat quarter each of pink purple and bright green

*\*Kits will be available for a cost of \$26 and will include the Pellon, freezer paper, Wonder Under and all fabrics needed to complete the scene.*

*To complete the landscape after class you will need fabric for binding, backing and borders, if you choose. We will not get to this step in class.*
